Needless to say is that once you get off the airplane at Pakistan airport, you immediately are aware that you are in enemy territory.

Being South African attracts a lot of attention, because we look different and we dress different. Everyone takes notice of your presence.

At first at the airport officials ask many questions about the purpose of your visit. They look through your luggage and especially when you book in to fly out of Pakistan they check your luggage several times.

This was the 5th time that we visited Pakistan. We have had many crusades and conferences before.

We were advised that we shouldn't conduct an open-air crusade by some people in Pakistan, but our host believed that all would be fine.

This time we only had a one-day crusade and conference and it was very blessed. At the crusade a local professor at one of the Bible Schools translated for me and we had so many salvations and testimonies of healings.



The people attended in big numbers having great expectancy.



We arrived in Nepal on Friday 20 November for a 3-day conference and crusade.

Seeing that it is the beginning of winter, Andries picked up a bit of the flu from Pakistan which he battled with throughout the crusade and conference. God is good though and gave him all the strength to see the life changing event through.

Nepal is facing a lot of challenges as they recently declared themselves a secular state. They get most of their fuel and gas from India and are now facing sanctions as their neighbours are not happy with the fact that they turned their back on being a Hindu state.

Cars and motorbikes are queuing for kilometres to get fuel. This must have had an effect on the attendance at the crusade field.

God always makes a way and even though the field was not as full as we wanted it to be, we had the TV and radio broadcasting the event live every day. The tv station that broadcast the first day's crusade was threatened by other faith groups and they withdrew but we managed to get another tv station to broadcast the message.



Approximately 200 pastors and leaders attended the “Jesus for Nepal” conference every day with one focus and that was “how to win Kathmandu for Jesus”.

A few gaps were identified in as far as training is concerned and we trust that God will give us the necessary partners to address these gaps.
