

NEWBORN MINISTRY IN TANZANIA – JUNE 2015

TUNDUMA CRUSADE AND CONFERENCE

This is the seventh year that we are visiting Tanzania for a crusade/s and conference/s. God always does more than we can pray or think.

We arrived on Monday 8 June and slept over in Dar-Es-Salaam. Early on Tuesday morning – at 7am – we flew to Mbeya. On our arrival in Mbeya we were welcomed by the Pastors of Tunduma. Tunduma is about 100km from Mbeya.



As we drove into Tunduma, we were welcomed by a procession and we drove through the town, while pamphlets were distributed and announcements were made from a truck, fully equipped with speakers, generator and about 20 church members.



This made me think of when Jesus went around and great crowds of people followed Him because they were expectant that something great would happen.

The procession ended on the crusade field where I gave a short word of thanks and referred to the woman who suffered from a blood issue. She was also expectant that if she could only touch the robe of Jesus, that she would be healed. I encouraged the people to put their trust in Jesus, because the Word says: “Those who put their trust in Him, shall not be disappointed.”

We were totally surprised with our accommodation in Tunduma. Tunduma lies right on the border of Tanzania and Zambia and I suspect that is why we found such good accommodation in Tunduma. The hotel is sparkling clean and we felt right at home.



On Wednesday we started with the first night of the 5-night crusade and it was clear that many people were reluctant to act on the Word. Every night people came forward for salvation, but not the 80-90% that we usually experience. I asked people to pray against the strongholds of the devil and every night a great crowd of people attended the crusade but they were still reluctant to come forward for the salvation prayer.

On the third night we experienced a breakthrough as the demonic started to manifest and on the final night 90% of the people came forward for salvation. Hallelujah to Jesus and thank you for praying.



The conference was a great success and the pastors attended with great enthusiasm as we spoke about vision and



“what you say is what you get”. The Bishop of the church where the conference was held invited me to preach at the Sunday service and I preached about the Blood of Jesus. Oh, what a blessing it was to all of us.



On Monday morning we left Tunduma for Mbeya where we will start our next crusade and conference on Wednesday.

Tonight I will have a radio interview on Baraka Radio and we trust that revival will break out in Tunduma and Mbeya.
