People were very happy to see us and greeted and welcomed us with open arms. Tanzania has a big Muslim community and even Muslim people were waiving at us as the procession was moving through town.

We were once more privileged to have Clasina Erasmus with us. This time she also presented at the Pastor’s Conference and it was very blessed. The Pastor interpreting her was so impressed that he invited her to preach at his church that Sunday.

Bunda shall never be the same again!!


Report came in that the Sunday after the crusade, people who never went to church joined the church where Clasina and Theresa went to preach.
